Farm Bill Priorities

AgForward will advance the following Farm Bill research policy recommendations that were laid out in the October 2017 coalition letter to Congress:

- 1. Pursue a doubling in USDA food and agricultural research funding
- 2. Renew and make permanent USDA competitive grant programs currently receiving direct mandatory Farm Bill funding
- 3. Establish a Strategic Investment Fund (SIF) under the direction of the USDA Office of the Chief Scientist to improve collaboration in addressing emerging opportunities, urgent threats, and/or research requiring greater interdisciplinary approaches across multiple agencies
